

Troop 540 Appointed Positions

Junior Assistant Scoutmaster: Serves in the capacity of Assistant Scoutmaster by advising SPL, assist instructors, etc., as assigned by the Scoutmaster. **Required rank and age: Life, 16, and previous youth leadership experience.**

Troop Guide: Works with new scout patrol. **Required rank: 1st Class, and PL or APL preferred.**

Scribe: Keep Troop records. Records activities of PLC, attendance, and dues. **Required rank: Tenderfoot, and one year in scouting.**

Quartermaster (2): Works with adult Troop Quartermaster to track and maintain equipment. **Required rank: 1st Class, and one year in scouting.**

Webmaster: Works with adult Webmaster to develop and maintain the troop's website. **Required rank 1st class, and one year in scouting.**

Order of the Arrow (OA) Rep: Works with Troop Arrowmen. Plans for ordeal weekends. **Required Rank: 1st Class, and OA membership required.**

Historian: Keeps a historical record or scrapbook of Troop activities. **Required rank: Tenderfoot, and one year in scouting.**

Chaplain's Aide: Works to meet religious needs of Scouts. Promotes the religious awards program. **Required Rank: 2nd Class, and PL, APL, or TG.**

Den Chief: Works with Cub Scouts, Webelos Scouts, and the Den Leaders in a Cub Scout Pack. **Required Rank: 1st class. May be waived if close to 1st Class. One year in Scouting.**

Instructor: Teaches Scouting skills. Works closely with TG and ASM for First Year Scouts. **Required Rank: 1st Class, PL, APL or TG preferred.**

Challenge Meister: Works with SPL to develop challenging games and skills for the Troop.

Required Rank: Tenderfoot, and one year in scouting.

Bugler: Works with SPL to provide reveille, taps, call to assembly, and other bugler services.

Required Rank: Tenderfoot, and one year of scouting.
